A Message from the Principal

Attention 6th Graders....

The **First Lego League**, also known as FLL, will begin next Wednesday, October 5th. If you are interested in designing, programming and competing tasks this may be the right club for you. Students are asked to work collaboratively to share their knowledge, compare ideas and display a robot.



The competition is split into three judged areas and a live robot run.

* The first judging session, **Core Values**, is designed to detect how the team works together and uses the FLL Core Values, which includes *Teamwork, Gracious Professionalism and “Coopertition”*. Teams are also asked to perform teamwork exercises.

* The next session is the **Robot Design**. The team explains how they designed their robot and demonstrates their programs to the judges.

* The third session is the **Project** where the students must research a topic related to the current challenge and create an innovative solution.

* **Finally**, the students must use the robots they designed and built to autonomously complete a set of tasks on a challenge mat.

This year Ms. Brown and Mrs. Stork will continue their advisership for FLL and work on a theme entitled **“Animal Allies”**. Last year **“The Programming Panthers”** at BMGS did extremely well in the first year. We are looking forward to a great 2nd year competition filled with fun and success.
