Dear Parents:

Upon the passing of the school budget, the Babylon district will once again offer a summer instrumental music program. This wonderful program is available to two sets of music students at Babylon Memorial GS: **Beginning** Band students and **returning** String students.

Registration information for **beginning** band students will be sent home in May, and they will be assigned their instrument before the end of the school year. **String students entering 4th, 5th and 6th grade** will be eligible to participate in the summer program. See the schedule below.

The Summer Program will run from *July 5th and will end on Thursday August 3rd*. It runs from Monday to Thursday. Due to summer construction projects at the GS and HS, this year's program will be held at the Elementary School. Detailed summer program information will be sent home in June. Students are encouraged to participate in the program even if they have to miss some time because of vacation trips or camp. **Also, please make every effort to attend the first week of lessons since the first week is the most important week.**

Lesson times are as follows:

9AM: FLUTE/TRUMPET/INCOMING 4TH GRADE STRING STUDENTS

10AM: CLARINET/TROMBONE/BARITONE HORN/INCOMING 5TH GRADE STRING STUDENTS

11AM: ALTO SAXOPHONE/PERCUSSION/INCOMING 6TH GRADE STRING STUDENTS

All lessons will last approximately 45 minutes

There will be a brief concert held during each hour on Thursday, August 3rd.

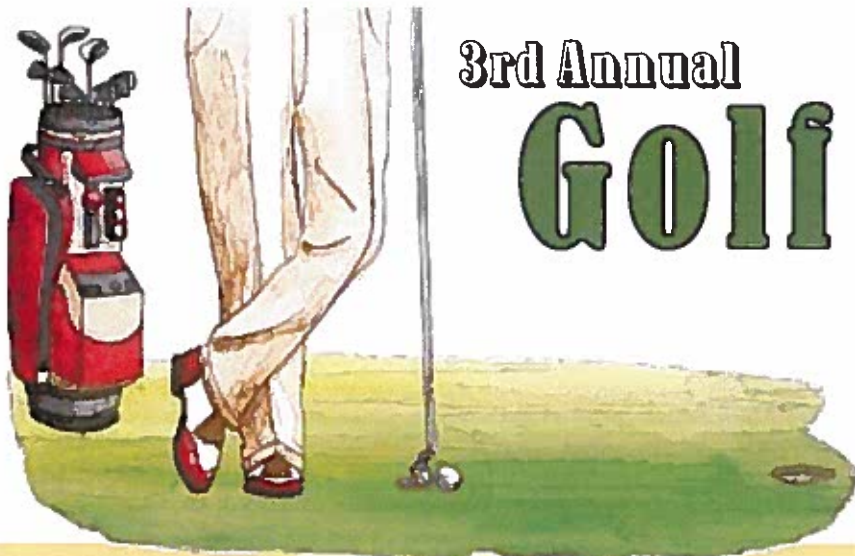
