Each student will be asked to take a kindness pledge and sign their names on a banner that will be displayed in the cafeterias throughout the year. *Enclosed is a bracelet for all students to wear to remember this special message.*

As part of this special month, PTA and the Social Emotional Learning Committee is sponsoring Random Acts of Kindness Challenges. All students in Babylon Elementary School and Babylon Grade School are encouraged to participate in these challenges and help make our community a "kinder" place.

Attached is a calendar of Kindness Challenges. **As your child completes a challenge, have them fill in a raffle that they can submit to their teacher or place in the WONDER bucket in the Main Office.** Prizes will be drawn weekly and will include Scholastic book money gift cards, among other things. It is a 5k trail run with obstacles on this run... *zombies*. Each runner will start off with a flag belt and three flags. *These flags represent runner lifelines*. Zombies throughout the course will be attempting to take these one at a time. If a runner finishes the race with at least one flag, they've survived, *but* if zombies have taken all of a runner's flags, while the runner can still complete the race, they will not be eligible for awards.
