With the hiring of important members of the faculty and staff, we continue to prepare our campuses and classrooms for your child’s happy arrival on opening day. Specifically, the 2019/2020 school year will continue to champion impressive additions to our facilities and enhancements to our strong instructional, artistic and athletic programs. Here are some updates:

- ✓ District-Wide Technology
 - The District has purchased all remaining 75” LED interactive TV’s for instruction and learning; every classroom throughout the district will be equipped with this new technological tool come September!

- ✓ Curriculum & Instruction
 - The District is launching a new science curriculum in grades 3-6, an extension of the curriculum that aligns with the K-2 science curriculum we implemented last year. Both levels align with the NextGen Science Standards.
 - A new hydroponics STEAM Center has been created at Babylon Junior-Senior High School. This will be a living laboratory that we anticipate will eventually serve as a STEAM center for all K-12 students to enjoy!
 - The new year will also mark the 7th year partnering with Columbia University’s Teachers College Reading & Writing Project, as well as the 4th year partnering with “Project Lead the Way” through the Rochester Institute of Technology. Several engineering and computer science offerings within our PLTW pathways provide students an opportunity to earn college credit.
 - This September also marks the fall expansion of FLES, K-6 instruction (Foreign Language in the Elementary School), with a focus on the Spanish language.

The District's Strategic Plan, titled "The Way Forward", is now in its 5th year of implementation. This document, by design, has the overarching goal of creating a set of long-range educational goals for our students, all designed to educate the "whole child" while embracing academic rigor, educational opportunities and enriched experiences for all children. The plan's priorities and anchor goals continue to drive all we do and all conversations we have. I look forward to sharing our past successes, the year's vision and long-term vision later in the fall. Please also join me during the four scheduled "Coffee with the Superintendent" day and evening sessions noted in the district calendar throughout the year.

Finally, with the start of a new academic year comes the time when we annually remember and commemorate **National Patriot Day on Wednesday, September 11, 2019**. It will be a day of remembrance as well as an opportunity to honor the brave men and women who continue to serve in our communities.
